Professor N.L. Sachdeva joined Delhi College of Engineering as a Lecturer in Mechanical Engineering in the year 1966. He holds the Masters-degree in Mechanical Engineering from IIT-Madras and Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering from M.B.M. Engineering College, Jodhpur (Rajasthan). Professor Sachdeva became professor in the Mechanical Engg. Deptt. in 1978.

Professor Sachdeva has a distinction of holding the Charge of the officiating Principal of the Delhi College of Engineering from August 1998 to-July 2000.

He is Life member of various professional institutes and societies i.e. Institute of Engineers (India), Indian Society of Technical Education, Indian Society of Mechanical Engineers and Indian Society for Construction Materials and Structures.

He has contributed immensely in the field of mechanical engineering and material sciences. He has presented technical papers in various workshops and conferences i.e. (i) Presented a paper title G.I.D- criteria for G. F.P.M at the several conference of I.S.M.E held at IIT-DHU in Jan 1979 (ii) Contributed a paper entitled "Some experimental studies relating to the Static Strength of Composites" for the National Symposium on large deformations at IIT-Delhi in Dec 1979 (iii) Presented a paper entitled "Truss Gate Design using J-Integral Parameter" in a UGC conference on solid mechanics held at University of Roorkee in March 1980 (iv) Contributed an article entitled "Fiber Composites-Structural materials with promise" in the journal of JSCDMA.
