Shri Sanjay Nayer is a graduate of Delhi College of Engineering of 1982 Mech batch and is an MBA Finance from IIM, Ahmedabad.

He joined Citigroup and spent 24 years and 1000+ hours to the level of CEO of Cit's Indian and South Asian operations. He was a member of Citigroup's Asia Executive Operating Committee and Global Senior Leadership Committee.

Mr. Nayer was the Deputy Chairman of the Indian Banks' Association (IBA), Chairman of the Foreign Banks' Committee of the IBA, USIBC, Co-Chairman of the Habitat for Humanity India Build campaign. He also participated in various financial sector reform committees set up by the Indian government and domestic regulators.
